YCBC Gala Entry Policy

Introduction

York City Baths Club is a competitive swimming club operating in a variety of pools in York.

We provide great opportunities for swimmers of all abilities, from swimming lessons within our very own learn to swim scheme, through to competitive swimming training within our squad programme.

The club follows the principles of the Athlete Development Support Pathway model and focuses entirely on the development of the skill in a fun and friendly swimming environment. Swimmers at York City Baths Club compete in a variety of competitions, ranging from Club Championships to International Meets.

Our aim is to teach York to swim and swim fast within a sustainable, high quality environment, which encourages all swimmers to reach their optimum potential through a diverse and effective programme.

What

Gala alerts will be sent out to parents/ guardians by email and will include all relevant information such as the gala schedule, gala conditions and qualifying times.

Why

There are specific dates and times that YCBC must process all the clubs entries to ensure that they are registered.

Where a gala is first come first served meeting the deadline is important to ensure the clubs entries have the best chance of being accepted.

Level 1 gala's have specific entry times and capacities which can result in rejections

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When

Each gala alert will have an internal closing date. All entries must be submitted by parents before this closing date. Any entries received after this will not be accepted.

Any amendments or changes to events can only be made before the internal closing date. Parents should initially contact the squad coach to discuss this.

Gala entry fees will be taken on GoCardless about a week after the internal closing date for the gala. For any level 1 galas where there is a chance that not all entries will be accepted, payment will be taken once the accepted entries have been confirmed.

If a swimmer is withdrawing from any events or all events at the gala, parents should email the squad coach and the gala secretary at the earliest possible convenience.

How

If parents need support with event selection or require any entry times for new events for their child, please contact the squad coach by email.

Parents should email squad coaches at least 24 hours prior to the closing date to allow them time to respond.

If a swimmer swims faster than the entry time at another gala after the closing date and before competing at the gala the entry times will not be updated.

Who

The YCBC Gala Secretary is appointed to process all entries and deal with any correspondence or queries in line with this policy. Please Email ycbc.galasecretary@gmail.com instead of replying direct to the gala alert email.
